



LEED-NC Standard 2.1

EcoStar Roofing Materials associated with and will contribute to obtaining points in 4 factors in the LEED-NC Standard 2.1

1. Construction Waste Management

- MR Credit 2.1 Construction Waste Management: Divert 50% from landfill – 1 pt
- MR Credit 2.2 Construction Waste Management: Divert 75% – 2 pt

- **Reuse or redirect**

Board-stock Insulation such as

- Nail Board
- Vent Board
- Foam insulation boards

If the existing EcoStar products are carefully removed, they can be reused.

Opportunities

- Reuse insulation if board stock
- If the existing EcoStar products are carefully removed, they can be reused.

- **Recycle**

All EcoStar products (Majestic, Designer, Colonial, Seneca) can be taken back and recycled.

2. Resource Reuse

- MR Credit 3.1 Resource Reuse: 5% – 1 pt
- MR Credit 3.2 Resource Reuse: 10% – 2 pt

Opportunities

- Reuse insulation if board stock
 - If the existing EcoStar products are carefully removed, they can be reused.

3. Recycle Content

- Class A rated tile – 70% post-industrial
 - Class C rated tile – 80% post-industrial

4. Regional Materials: See map

- Note: Projects outside the 500 radius – remember:
 - 73% less weight than Tile per sq ft – minimum
 - 67% less weight than Slate per sq ft – minimum
 - Equal in weight to laminated shingles and shake per sq ft
 - Colonial is equal to three-tab shingles in weight per sq ft
 - As seen above in specific cases, EcoStar's weigh advantage equates to more square footage on a truckload requiring less trucks.
